# **FACILITIES**

Tiivistämö has two separate event spaces: the Main Hall and the Bar (Lämpiö), which are connected. Additionally, the venue includes a foyer, backstage areas, storage spaces, and restrooms located on the lower floor. The backyard may also be available for use, depending on the circumstances.

Total area of Tiivistämö: 620 m²
Maximum capacity of the Main Hall: 440 people
Maximum capacity of the bar: 120 people

# **Renting Tiivistämö**

Tiivistämö can be rented for public events as well as private functions.

Pricing depends on the details and timing of the event, so rental fees are always negotiated individually.

The Lobby and Main Hall cannot be rented separately, as they share the same entrance and restroom facilities.

The rental fee always includes the venue, furniture, stage technology, technical staff, cleaning, and basic infrastructure.

#### **MAIN HALL**

The Main Hall at Tiivistämö is highly adaptable for various types of events. It can accommodate up to 440 people at once. The seated audience area holds approximately 200 guests, while table seating can accommodate around 100.

The walls of the hall are covered with black, fire-resistant Molton curtains, behind which are tall windows that can provide natural light if needed. The technical workstations are located at the back of the hall.

The floor is made of lacquered concrete.

The Main Hall has access to the bar, backstage areas, and the Lobby.

#### STAGE

Stage dimensions:

Width: 7 mDepth: 5 mHeight: 0.8 m

The stage can be extended with additions such as a catwalk, and risers can be built for drums or speakers.

Access to the stage is via stairs at the back. Stairs can also be installed at the front if needed. Additionally, the stage is accessible via a wheelchair lift.



# BAR (LÄMPIÖ)

The bar - aka 'Lämpiö' - is a garage-style space located next to the Main Hall. It features a bar, a small stage, and stage technology, including lighting, a sound system, a projector, and a screen.

The interior design of the bar embraces an urban second-hand aesthetic, while the original brick walls reflect the industrial charm of the early 1900s.

The maximum capacity of the Lobby is 120 people, with seating for approximately 60 guests at tables.

The bar has direct access to both the foyer and the Main Hall. The doors provide good sound insulation, allowing separate programs or events to take place simultaneously in the Main Hall and the bar.

At both ends of the bar, there are large loading doors that can be opened to the front and back yards if needed.

For private events utilizing the entire venue, the buffet table is often set up in the bar.



#### **RESTROOMS**

The restrooms are located downstairs in two separate rooms. They can be designated as unisex or Men/Women based on the nature of the event. An accessible restroom is available upstairs near the main entrance.

Cleaning and maintenance of the restrooms are handled by Tiivistämö unless otherwise agreed.



#### **LOBBY**

The lobby features coat racks as well as counters for coat check and ticket sales. Tables can be set up for catering or merchandise as needed.

An information screen on the wall can display images, text, or videos. A red carpet can also be arranged if required.

The lobby provides access to the outdoors, the Main Hall, the Lobby, and the restrooms.

#### BACKSTAGE

The backstage area includes a private lounge for performers and event organizers, equipped with a refrigerator and a large mirror.

Additional amenities include an iron and ironing board, a fan, a hairdryer, dishes, and towels.

Adjacent to the backstage area, there is also a staff break room available for performers and event organizers. This space includes a printer, a small kitchen with dishware, a shower, restrooms, and a backdoor exit.





#### **BACKYARD**

The backyard is accessible through the Lobby and backstage areas. It can be used as a terrace or even set up with a temporary stage for events. The area is not covered. Outdoor spaces beyond the backyard are managed by Kaapelitalo Ltd, and their use must be coordinated with them.

#### **BAR SERVICES**

Tiivistämö can accommodate large buffets, breakfast coffee services, and welcome drinks.

Bar services are provided by Beaver City Restaurants Itd. The entire venue is a licensed serving area, meaning all alcohol service is exclusively handled by the them.

An exception is backstage catering for performers, which can be fully managed by the event organizer.

Self-arranged food catering is possible but must be discussed separately with the bar operator.

Bar counters can be set up in the Main Hall, the Lobby, and the foyer.

#### **SECURITY SERVICES**

Tiivistämö's security and cloakroom services are provided by Local Crew Ltd.

As a general rule, at least one security guard is required per 100 guests, but security needs are planned on a case-by-case basis.

If a paid cloakroom service is used, the fee for guests is €3.

#### **AGE RESTRICTIONS**

All-ages events can be hosted at Tiivistämö; however, any designated 18+ alcohol service areas must be sectioned off and supervised.

#### **ACCESSIBILITY**

Tiivistämö provides accessible entry to nearly all areas, except for the downstairs restrooms. An accessible restroom is available near the main entrance.

The Artist Lounge in the backstage area is not fully accessible, as there is a small threshold at the door, and the door width is 81 cm.

The stage is accessible via a wheelchair lift (Lehner, Liftboy 2).

A wheelchair lift is also available between the bar and the lobby.

# **Entrances**

Tiivistämö's main entrance is elevated above street level and is accessible via a fixed ramp, though assistance may be needed.

The Bar entrance is at street level.

The backstage entrance located in the backyard is not accessible.

# **FIRE SAFETY EQUIPMENT**

Fire safety equipment is marked on the floor plan. Tiivistämö is equipped with fire extinguishers, a fire hose reel, and a smoke extraction system.

#### FIRST AID AND DEFIBRILLATOR

Tiivistämö is equipped with first aid kits and a defibrillator, which is located at the cloakroom counter in the foyer.

# ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

Tiivistämö is committed to the EcoCompass environmental management system and follows the City of Helsinki's environmental protection guidelines.

#### **SAFER SPACE PRINCIPLES**

Tiivistämö has established Safer Space Principles that all event organizers and performers must commit to following. This guideline is designed to make Tiivistämö as safe as possible for all participants. We encourage everyone to actively foster an atmosphere where the safety and well-being of others are prioritized. Let's take care of each other.

If you experience harassment or any inappropriate behavior at an event, please reach out to the staff. You can find staff members at the technical workstations, cloakroom, ticket sales, bar, or backstage areas.

- Respect personal physical and mental space. You cannot assume another person's boundaries without asking. Always ask before touching someone. Listen and adjust your behavior if someone tells you that your actions make them uncomfortable.
- Respect everyone and avoid making assumptions. Do not assume anyone's sexuality, gender, nationality, ethnicity, religion, values, socioeconomic background, abilities, or health status.
- No body shaming. Do not comment on another person's body. Refrain from making remarks about other people's meals or eating habits.
- Respect others' opinions, beliefs, experiences, and differing viewpoints. Do not mock, ridicule, degrade, exclude, or embarrass anyone through your words, actions, or behavior.
- Give space. Ensure that everyone has the opportunity to participate in conversations. Do not dominate discussions, and allow others to speak. Respect people's privacy and handle sensitive topics with care.
- Address harassment if you witness it. Ask the affected person if they would like help or support. Do not remain a passive bystander.

#### **ARRIVAL**

#### **LOCATION & ACCESS**

Tiivistämö is located in the heart of Suvilahti, in building number 5. Suvilahti does not have street names or numbered addresses, so all buildings share the addresses Kaasutehtaankatu 1 or Sörnäisten rantatie 22.

**Taxis** can usually find Tiivistämö or nearby landmarks such as Cirko, Stadin Panimo, or Peloton.

The nearest **metro** station is Kalasatama, but Sörnäinen is also within a short walking distance. Suvilahti is easily accessible by bus and city bike.

**Bus:** The closest stops are Suvilahti stop, Tynnyrintekijänkatu stop, and Kalasatama stop.

# **ARRIVING BY CAR & PARKING**

There is a parking area in Suvilahti where parking is allowed in designated spaces. Parking is free for the first three hours, after which the fee is €2 per hour or €16 per day. The Suvilahti parking area also includes accessible parking spaces (LE spots) and electric vehicle charging stations.

The payment machine is located on the south side of the adjacent building (Puhdistamo, building 6).

The nearest parking garage is Redi Parking Hall, where the fee is €1.40 per 30 minutes and €30 per day.
